In keeping with goals set in 2017, the Heart of Texas Baptist Network and its Coordinating Board approved a revised budget for 2018 in the January Board Meeting. This includes the creation and staffing of a new position - Network Director of Communications.

The Heart of Texas Baptist Network is pleased to announce that Angelia Bostick has assumed this part-time position as of February, 2018. Angelia comes to us from a lifetime of service in the community as a NAMB missionary, director of two faithbased non-profits, community leader, and equipper of disciples. She understands the work of the Network and the local churches.

Angelia worked with the Association as a Mission Service Corps volunteer from 1991-1993 in the development and organization of Good Samaritan Ministries and served as its first director from 1993-2016. She has also served on the organizing boards of other local non-profits such as CWJC, CASA, Brownwood Area Community Garden, Loaves and Fishes and Brown County Home Solutions. She is an excellent communicator and we very much look forward to working with her on our Network staff and team. We believe that Angelia will help us address the single biggest administrative need we have in the Network — communication — to the local churches, our communities, and

MACEDONIA



Network Missionary, Don Fawcett, traveled with Neill Trull, former pastor of Calvary Baptist Church, Brownwood, to Macedonia. They departed DFW airport on February 19, 2018 and returned on March 4. This trip was a strategic probe and follow-up on the previous three trips conducted during 2017. The team spoke in churches in the following Macedonian cities: Marvinci, Negotino, Kumanovo, Skopje (capital city), and Gevgelija. They also visited two cities where there are **no** evangelical churches: Tetovo and Gostivar. The Macedonian church leaders are reaching out to these cities and raising up indigenous leaders to plant churches. While there, Don and Neill preached and taught, listened to and prayed with leaders, and offered encouragement. They took field notes to evaluate how the Heart of **Texas Network might** continue a strategic

NIGERIA



A team will return to Nigeria in June of 2018. This team includes Don and Bobbie Fawcett, Jennifer Goins, Chelsey Jones, and Etla Van Horn. Bobbie teaches children with special needs and will work with educators there to strengthen their programs. She will also evaluate books for a children's reading library that will serve the community of Egbe, Nigeria and the CARE Africa ministry.

Jennifer, Chelsey and Etla are Registered Nurses in the state of Texas and travelled with the Network to Nigeria in 2016. Etla holds a Masters in Nursing and is a nursing instructor at Ranger College. These ladies will conduct clinics in the Nigerian bush among the <u>Tiv</u> people group. These clinics offer AIDS screening, general health screening, and de-worming medication to the village children.

A tangible way to be a part of this team is to provide financial assistance to offset nurses. Please send donations to the Network Office and put in the memo, "Nigeria Mission-Team." All designated monies will be divided among the team members unless a church designates for a specific missionary, in which case they can make that clear with an attached note or letter stating the name of the missionary.

We want to give churches, Sunday School groups, children and adult mission groups an opportunity to partner with this medical team. Following is a list of ways you and your church can partner with the team:

BUDGET NEWS

In church year 2017, Network churches received \$8,168,247 in tithes and offerings. Churches shared \$149,148, or 1.83%, with the Network Office to accomplish our goals and mission.

At the end of 2017, the account balances were as follows: General Fund \$18.637.46

Mission Fund \$77,561.00

The Heart of Texas Baptist Network was able to retire the debt they carried on the Citizen's Bank loan taken out to remodel the former Jones Chapel church building in which we now office. This allowed the establishment of a new budget for 2018, which restored some of the cuts made in 2017. We feel this budget demonstrates renewed financial strength in the Network.
